2024 FIG Acrobatic Gymnastics World Championships and World Age Group Competitions

As you know in November 2023, the FIG Executive Committee decided not to organise the 2024 Acrobatic Gymnastics World Championships and World Age Group Competitions in Holon (ISR) in light of the current situation.

During this meeting the FIG EC allocate the 2026 Acrobatic Gymnastics World Championships to Holon (ISR).

The bidding procedure for the 2024 event was therefore been reopened for all national federations. Unfortunately, **no** bids were received before the deadline of 15 January 2024.

Finally, a candidature was received from POR (Guimarães) with many thanks to the Gymnastics Federation of Portugal.

We are very happy to inform you that, at its meeting in Kampala (Uganda), the FIG EC allocated 2024 FIG Acrobatic Gymnastics World Championships and World Age Group Competitions to Portugal (Guimarães) in September 2024.

The WAGC will take place on 12-15 September 2024 and the WCH from 19-22 September 2024

The directives for the event will be send out as soon as possible and all registrations will restart from zero.

On behalf of the FIG ACRO TC and after all the uncertainties, we hope to welcome you all in Guimarães-Portugal in September 2024.

Let's make this event a celebration of our beautiful discipline.

On behalf of the ACRO TC, I extend heartfelt wishes for a prosperous, healthy, and successful 2024. Let's work hard to make ACRO more famous around the world. We can do it together!!!

Acro Event reports

1. European ACRO Championships

The events took place in Varna, Bulgaria in the period 12-22 October 2023.

In the Age groups, a noteworthy addition was Slovakia, making it 22 countries in total. The overall competition showcased an impressive standard of quality. Despite the unofficial status of M4, resulting from Israel's late withdrawal and a decrease in participation, Greece demonstrated remarkable progress, solidifying its standing in this category. Switzerland also secured its first-ever medal, marking a significant achievement.

Now, looking at the Juniors and Seniors categories, there was a positive trend in increased participation:

Total National Federations (NF): 21 (249 gymnasts)

Juniors NF: 17 (144 gymnasts), Seniors NF: 17 (105 gymnasts)

Despite the absence of major acrobatics countries such as Russia, Belarussia and Israel due to the war in their countries, the competition witnessed a general improvement in performance. Unfortunately, both MP and M4 events had to be labeled unofficial due to insufficient participation after Israel's withdrawal.

In the juniors, medals were distributed among 10 countries, with Italy securing the 3rd place in the medal ranking. At seniors level, 8 countries claimed the medals, with notable dominance from AZE in MP and MxP events, and BEL in the trio category.

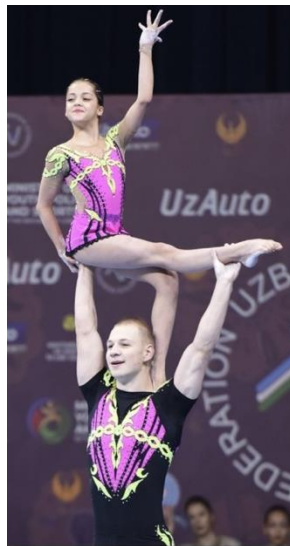




2. 13th Asian Acrobatic Gymnastics Championships

The 13th Junior and Senior Asian Acrobatic Gymnastics Championships took place in Tashkent from October 18 to 20. The event concluded with a dazzling display of acrobatic prowess. Teams from Hong Kong, India, Kazakhstan, Tajikistan, and Uzbekistan showcased their talent, with approximately 170 athletes competing across four age categories.

Unfortunately, the North Korean team was unable to attend due to an injury to the top of the mixed pair, and the Chinese team was unable to participate due to important domestic competitions in China. The judges panel was assembled from category 2, 3 and 4 judges from all of the above countries, only the Difficulty judge was invited from Georgia. The Hong Kong and Indian teams have stepped up very well. The atmosphere was wonderful, everyone was very happy to meet and conduct the competition with brilliance. Big thanks to the Uzbekistan Gymnastics Federation to host this AGU ACRO Championships.



3. The Pan American Acro Championships



After a very late withdrawal by the planned host, the Colombian Gymnastics Federation President, Samir Portillo, saved the 2023 Pan American Acro Championships by agreeing to take the event at the last minute. This time the event took place in the city of Ibagué at the Coliseo Mayor de Ibagué, perhaps better known as the “Space Ship” Venue. The venue was open on all sides. So the 79 participating athletes competed against a beautiful backdrop of the mountains surrounding the city.

Six countries participated, Brazil, Canada, Colombia, Mexico, Puerto Rico, and the United States.

The judges were excited to have the opportunity to learn from the invited CJP, Juan Antonio León Prados, ESP. Much time was spent discussing the Artistry judging forms and it was very helpful to have his expertise.

Much appreciation to the Colombian Gymnastics Federation for hosting the PAGU Championships for the second year in a row. The organizing committee worked very hard to provide a quality event. And all the participants were grateful for their warm hospitality.



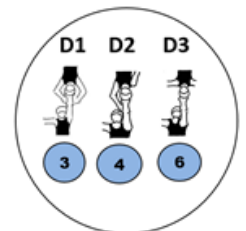
Questions and answers

1. Question: TOD p. 20 – D1 – D2 – D3

As the IDs and points of support of these positions different, can you confirm that the following positions are considered different?

Answer: Yes. By the current TOD, these three positions are different.

Rational: 1. Because they have a separate ID
2. Compare with other top positions (on 2 hands, 2 on 1 or on 1 hand) all on 1 hand of the base



2. Question: Can we use base positions from the same category during the transitional pyramid?

Answer: YES. To consider as a transition the base positions must be from one box to another. (Not from one Cat. to another). Also, see COP Art. 20.11 and Art. 20.12.

3. Question: Can the base in table position (photo bellow) also perform this element in a bridge position (drawing)?



Answer: Yes and the element with the base in bridge position is considered as a variant of pg 67 A 11 V 17 (same coordinates and same value)

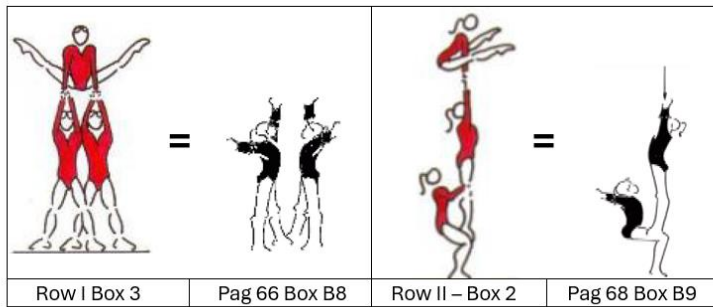
Clarifications

- 11-16 groups

Art 4.3 The Optional Pyramid may be selected from one of the same categories used for the Compulsory Elements. (Not a variant of a compulsory pyramid).

This means that variants of the compulsory pyramids of the same box in the TOD can **NOT** be done as an optional element.

Examples of pyramids that are considered as the same:

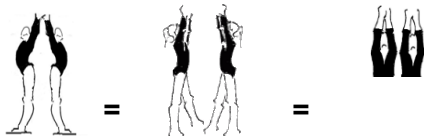


- **Base positions WG:**

- 1) By analogy with what was published in newsletter № 7 the following base position is considered as a variant of base position on **pg 68 D 5 V16** when the base is holding the middle partner on the leg.



- 2) 2 bases on the floor back to back = variant of Pg 66 B 6 = 2 bases face to face or variant of 2 bases side by side



- **General:**

Published in previous newsletters elements who were considered as a variant in the past are still accepted as such when they are not inside the current TOD.

- **Mount Pairs:** Following Mount is considered as a variant of p. 31 E-B 24

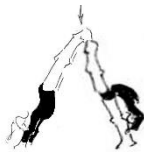

1. New element request

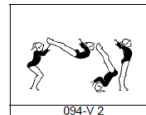
As a TC we have accepted the following position as a new element

2. Questions and answers

- **Q 1:** Hecht dive roll (ToD element no. 094) –



Is there a requirement to show hyperextension when performing the flight phase of the element?

A: Yes

If yes, and no hyperextension is shown, would it still count as the same element from a difficulty judge's point of view or should the value of the element be deducted?

A: E-judges: Pg 39 Art 46.5.2: Technical deduction lack of amplitude of an element. 0.1 to 0.5 depending on how it is performed.

- **Q 2:** During the performance of the transition, in the pyramid of 2 base positions from the same category, the trio falls during the transition phase of the element. The trio climbs back up and performs the second static hold.

What happens to the difficulty?

A: The difficulty value must be removed for both transition (v8) and second static hold (v18), since the second hold was performed from a separate construction so it is not a transitional pyramid anymore and the category of the pyramid can not be repeated (pg 21 Art 20.8)

- **Q 3:** WAGC rules 11-16, Art 2.9:

The landings of all dynamic elements and dismounts declared on the Tariff sheet must be supported. If the landing is performed without support, a 0.5 penalty is applied (DJ) for each occurrence.

How do we define **non-support**?

A: When the top lands alone without any assistance from the base (no physical contact).

- **Q 4:** WAGC AG 11-16 rules: Can in the Balance exercise the Round off be used (multiple times)?

A: Round off **doesn't** count as an element in the balance exercise. (see PPT 3, slide 6 of the Judges education on the STS platform of FIG)

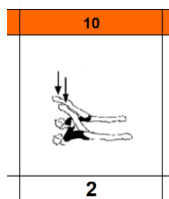

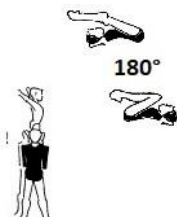

This means that the element is considered as the same as double tuck Value: 14+4

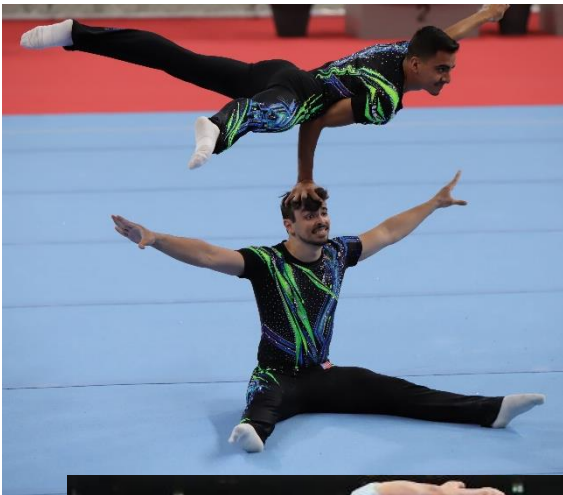
Report on the World Cup in Rzeszow(POL)

The last World Cup of the series in 2023 took place in Rzeszow Poland 9 – 11 June 2023.

With 101 participants from 15 countries, Azerbaijan, Belgium, China, Spain, Great Britain, Georgia, Germany, Ireland, Israel, Italia, Kazakhstan, Poland, Portugal, Ukraine, and USA this competition was this the biggest World Cup this year. After a long time, we had China back in the World Cup. This was really appreciated by the public and all participants.

The level was really high and the gymnasts presented amazing exercises. During the finals in all five categories gymnasts from 9 different countries won medals.

Many thanks to Polish Gymnastics Association and the organizing committee, who did a great job in organizing this event. It was great to be part of it.

3. FIG ACRO WORLD CUP-Puurs – BELGIUM

The organizers welcomed 12 countries, Austria, Azerbaijan, Belgium, Great Britain, Georgia, Germany, Ireland, Israel, Kazakhstan, Portugal, Ukraine, and the United States of America, coming from 3 different continents.

The gymnasts presenting amazing exercises to the public and delegations always very enthusiastic and cheering the gymnasts during their routines.

In this event participated 97 gymnasts, 16 judges, 31 coaches and 14 officials, all gave the best of themselves to make it a great competition for everyone, in the sport complex completely full, at home by live streaming or live broadcast on TV during the finals.

It was a great competition, in the final in the 5 categories, 9 countries were present in the award ceremonies.

1. **Q:** Is this element a horizontal catch or is the following rule affective in this element:
COP Art 23.3 page 24:
Swing and cannonball start– and finish positions are NOT considered as horizontal positions



A: This element is starting out of a swing start position but the **finish position is a horizontal catch.**

2. **Q:** Regarding individual No 62, how it needs to be performed - is it in box splits with chest on the floor or Japana (legs at 90 with chest on the floor)?



A: Both positions can be considered as individual element Pg 120 - Nr 62.

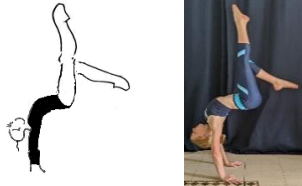

Questions for ACRO Artistic judging 2023-2024 – adjusted

The following small adjustments were added:

PARTNERSHIP
Is there an acceptable level of maturity between all partners?
Is there a good level of technical and physical preparation between all partners?
Is there a visible consistent connection between all partners?
PERFORMANCE
Is the flow continuous throughout ?
Do all partners have great amplitude in the exercise ?
Is there synchronization between all partners throughout?
Is it original Choreography?
Does the partnership create a personal identity ?
EXPRESSION
Do all partners project the emotion of the exercise?
Do they maintain the emotion throughout the exercise?
Is there Harmony of the expression between the partners?
CREATIVITY
Do they show originality and inventiveness in the overall exercise?
Do they have special/different ways to get in and out of elements?
Do they show a variety of elements and perform rarely staged elements ?
MUSICALITY
Is the choreography in harmony with the music throughout?
Is the exercise performed without any interruption between choreo and elements?
Are the musical sentences, accents respected and used throughout?

The FIG Acro TC had their first working meeting of 2023 in Lausanne from 2-5 February 2023.

We want to inform you about the following:

International Judges' course 2023

In February 2023 an International Judges' course was organised in Lausanne (SUI).

This course was giving the opportunity to a limited number of judges (ACRO 31 participants) to raise their category (from cat.4 to 3 or from cat.3 to 2). Following a one day course, the participants did a practical exam (D1,D2, A & E). 14 of the candidates were able to raise their category and additional 9 candidates can upgrade when they have the required experience. Congratulation to all.

Questions and answers

1. Q: 11-16 Compulsory Table Men's Pair Balance.

If a pair decides to do a series of Row IV box 3 (1" handstand to 3" straddle) to go into Row II box 6 (3" straddle to 3" crocodile), do they have to hold the straddle 2x 3" = 6", or just 3"?

A: When performed in a series : they have to hold the Straddle only 3" because it makes no sense at all to stay 6" in the same position.

2. Q: 11-16 Compulsory Table Women's Group Balance.

Row I box 5, is it supposed to be twice a 3" hold, or is it 1" to 3" (as the arrow goes both ways, implying only the second element needs to be 3")?

A: Twice a 3" hold. The arrows are only defining the direction (from straddle to crocodile OR from crocodile to straddle)

3. Q: The judges were instructed to take a deduction of 0.3 in execution when a base is standing too wide in stand and then goes to split, as it makes the motions to a split position much easier. Were can't we find this deduction in the CoP or Newsletters?

A: See Newsletter Nr 4 of the [previous cycle](#) (Cycle 2017-2021):


Clarification – In Pairs, when the base slides to splits, the starting position should be a normal standing position (feet approximately shoulder width apart). The base **MUST NOT** start with the feet so wide that they are almost half way to the split position before the motion of the base begins.




E- deduction: -0.3

Because the top would be on both of the bases feet, pg 61-Table 2 should be used for the value of the top position.

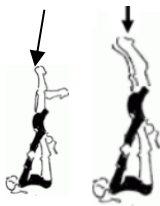
New Element requests:

- Base Pyramids Cat 2:

Dear Friends,



The FIG Acro TC had another working meeting in Lausanne from 7-12 December 2022.



We want to inform you about the following:

1. 12th Asian ACRO Continental Championships



The 12th Asian Championship for seniors and juniors was held in Pavlodar (Kazakhstan) from 25th till the 27th of September. Participating countries were Hong Kong, India, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan and Uzbekistan. The competition went great. The National team of Indian team brought 24 athletes, the emotions and compositions impressed the entire audience. The team of Kazakhstan and Uzbekistan among them had an interesting battle for the medals. Unfortunately Team Iran and Turkmenistan could not participate.



International judges from Azerbaijan, Georgia, Germany, Poland and South Africa were invited. Thanks to all of them. Beautiful medals, prepared for this competition by the Federation of Kazakhstan, were very appreciated by the participants. All the athletes went home with happy faces!

2. PAGU Acrobatic Continental Championships, Bogota, Colombia– November 18 – 20, 2022

After the postponement of the 2021 event, the 4th PAGU Acrobatic Gymnastics Championships took place with, Brazil, Canada, Colombia, Mexico, Puerto Rico, United States of America and Venezuela.

A total of 107 gymnasts participated in the competition, along with 15 judges, 19 coaches, and 31 officials, the event also provided the opportunity for a training camp for the Colombian team, and education for the judges.



For the first time roundtable of the PAGU countries was held, and the first official Pan American Acro athlete meeting, with 40 gymnasts present.

3. ACRO DEVELOPMENT CAMP IN ADIS ABABA, ETHIOPIA

From December 15th to 20th, 2022, an ACRO Training camp was held in Addis Ababa as part of the UAG Development Program. The Ethiopian Gymnastic Federation hosted the camp intending to develop acrobatic gymnastics in Ethiopia. The lectures and practical activities Nikolina Hristova (Vice President FIG ACRO TC) were held in Addis Ababa Gymnastics Federation Gymnasium, equipped with the most modest necessary conditions for developing acrobatic gymnastics.

A total of 38 participants: 16 coaches and 22 gymnasts followed each activity with great interest, curiosity, and excitement.





The camp included educational theoretical and practical introductory sessions to ACRO for coaches and gymnasts.

On the last day, the President of the Ethiopian Gymnastics Federation – Mr. Gebeyaw Takele visited the camp. He clearly expressed his intentions for the future development of acrobatic gymnastics in Ethiopia. He also says his expectation of the coaches and the gymnasts is to work very seriously and at a high technical level.

We want to express our gratitude to the African Gymnastic Union, and his President Dr. Ehab Amin Esawy as well as to Heba El-Bourini – UAG Secretary General for this opportunity and the desire to develop Acrobatic Gymnastics in Africa.

1. Questions & Answers

Q: 11-16 compulsory elements: Can a straight salto be performed with split legs?

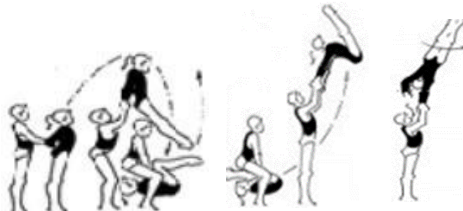
A: By the rules (pg 24 , Art 2.3) this is NOT allowed.

2.3 Each pair/group, in one exercise, must perform as in the drawings (See table of variations allowed, pg 31), the Compulsory Elements illustrated in the Compulsory Element Table.

2. Clarifications :

Element request :

Mount - Top goes from stand to cannonball swing, open in a dislocate motion, diamidov 360° or 720° to low or high handstand.



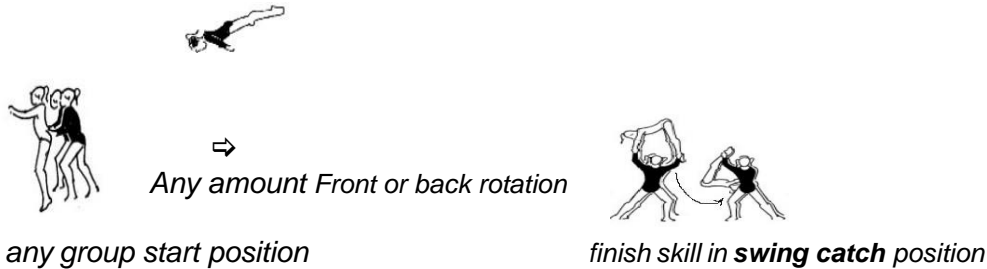
This skill is similar to mount pg. 32-E, however is different because the opening from cannonball to Diamidov is performed as a **dislocate** motion instead of **inlocate** (opens opposite).

After evaluation the FIG ACRO TC consider this as a variation of element A(disloc) on Pg 34 with additional value for (360° +4) and (720° +6)

New catch position:

Dynamic catch position - bases grab top's wrists and ankles and go into a swing - same as start position on pg. 78 #53.



The FIG ACRO TC accept this new finish position as a variant of following catch position: There is a - 2 value because the catch is horizontal with 4 point of support



D-Judging:

Q: During the performance of the below the pair falls during the motion phase of the element (slide to split). The pair climbs back up and performs the static hold (base in split top in handstand).

What happens with the difficulty??

- Should difficulty value be removed for the whole element, motion (v7) and static hold (v7), since the element declared was a motion into a static hold?
- Or should difficulty value for the motion be removed and value for the static hold (v7) only be given since the pair did rebuild and performed the static hold?

A: The FIG ACRO TC decided in favor for the gymnasts:

Difficulty value for the motion must be taken out and the value for the static hold (v7) can be given since the pair did rebuild and performed the static hold.

We also want to express our appreciation to Acro - Companion who facilitated for the first time the opportunity to judge the Technical Execution using a Real Time judging system. It was a really good experience which will help us to improve the fairness and accuracy in judging in the future.

3. Questions & Answers

Code of Points

1. **Q:** If the base of a pair moves to split, with the knee going first to the floor and then moves to split, does the element count for SR?

A: Yes in 12-18, Juniors and Seniors, this is only a different technique. In 11-16 these are different elements

2. **Q:** In slide to split, if attempting to slide directly to split (with straight legs), is there any execution deduction for touching the knee on the floor?

A: a deduction should be given when the back leg is not straight (and therefore it will touch the floor) (perfect lines and positions deduction: 0.1- 0.2)

3. **Q:** Is the motion of the base with 180° turn, for example, considered the same as the same motion without the turn?

A: No, Motions of the base with a turn are considered as a different element

4. **Q:** Does article 19.6 mean Base and/or Top?

A: Yes, Base AND Top

19.6: *The base and the top may not change the point of support during a motion.*

5. **Q:** There is a new deduction for a base in a sit position, with the legs open more than 90 degrees. Are we supposed to take this deduction?

A: Yes, the base will receive the correct deduction

6. **Q:** When you perform a Mount to a low arm, can you perform the same Mount to a high arm, or does it still count as the same Mount?

A: You will use the same element start box, so it is still the same mount.

7. **Q:** 20.18 is not for pairs?

A: The same reasoning is being used in Pairs but the article 20.18 is only for Groups

8. **Q:** In transitional pyramids, when you go from a 3 second hold into a 3 second and you go to stand on shoulders of your partners, value top is 0. While building second pyramid, there is a fall to the ground, do we use art. 21.3: no time faults OR is it 0,9 because pyramid already started?

A: Yes, 0.9

9. **Q:** When one of the transitional pyramids has a TF, the transitional value remains?




A: Yes

10. **Q:** If there is a fall during a transition and the 2 pyramids are of the **same** category, can they rebuild the second base pyramid??

A: No

11. **Q:** Is the following a repetition of category if they do?:

A: No

12. **Q:** In a transitional pyramid, if top maintains the same position throughout the transition and at the end of the transition moves to another position, the value of top's motion is seen in the difficulty group of the first base pyramid or in the difficulty group of the second base pyramid (since this is where the top motion is made)?

A: Value of the motion of the top is determined by the value of the BASE position on which the TOP is performing the motion, in this case the second one.

13. Q: The base(s) must start the motion before the top starts a motion. What does the DJ do for the element if this does not occur, and instead, the top start to move first?

A: In a motion or transition of the base(s) you receive the difficulty of the START position of the TOP. This means the TOP must be in a position of value at the moment the motion of the base(s) starts.

If the TOP is not in the Static position of the previous Static hold, they lose the value of the static hold of the Top DURING the motion /transition.

14. Q: Can we penalize a *reception* if the feet are *not* joined?

A: If you mean by “reception” landing on the floor after a P/G or individual element, yes there will be a deduction.

15. Q: Article 36.4: criteria for evaluation, in terms of the amplitude of performance, it says "choreographic elements". Should we judge choreography in *execution*?

A: Choreographic elements, example: “grand jeté or pirouette or jump with 720° turn”, **Yes**

JUDGING ARTISTRY

16. Q: If one or more partners falls in the Choreo **at same time**, is it 1,0 or 2,0 points in falls?

A: **1.0 point**

17. Q: When is there a fall in a series, what is the impact on artistic judgment?

A: it depends on the impact in the flow of the exercise and results always in a lower mark in “performance”.

TABLES OF DIFFICULTY

18. Q: Do the legs together +1 value from general rules ever apply during **a motion**, if the legs are together the whole time?

A: Legs together + 1 can be added in a static **position of the top and during a motion of the base**

19. Q: Pg 15 - other arch/ring positions, is there any plus value for these positions:



A: No, only the ones indicated on Pg 7 the others are considered as a variant of the original with the same value and the same ID.

20. Q: The minus (-) value in the general rules regarding to the motion of the base are only applied to the motion and not the motion + static position of the base correctly?

A: Yes, correct only in the motion of the base

21. Q: Mounts - Pg 28 - A... Is this skill with a tuck or pike shape?

A: It is just a jump into handstand and you can choose how.

Q: If tuck, can the +2 value for performance in pike apply to this mount?

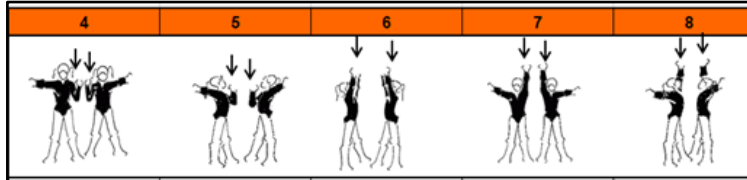

22. Q: Base position in WG, two bases on the floor, the additional value for handstand in WP and WG of the General rules in the TOD on Pg 9 be applied?

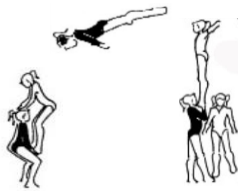
A: No, for these positions you don't receive the Additional value.



23. Q: Finish position from the general rules for WP DYN box 4 minus value finish position, does that position also count for additional difficulty for WP DYN salto with 4/4 rotation or more caught in the hands of the base?

A: Landing with the shoulders in the hands of the Base and landing with the hands of the TOP on the Shoulders of the Base are NOT considered as "Caught in Hands" so **NO additional Value** is given.

24. Q: Is it applicable for WG when one of the bases catch to the top in the hands 4/4 vertical position?
For example. 74, 1, 4-U / V 22.



General Rules

• **Additional Difficulty for WOMEN'S PAIR Dynamic:**

1. Saltos with **4/4** rotation or more, **caught in the hands** of the base, Top in vertical position, receive an additional value of **+4**

Examples:



A: NO. This +V is applying only for WP dynamic and not for WG. In women's groups this catch is already rewarded in the TOD

25. Q: Can this position be used as a catch position? If so, would it be identified as "V" finish position? Variation of bases side by side?

A: Yes



Q: Please clarify where second base's hands can be? Only under support of the foot? Can they be around the ankle or calf?

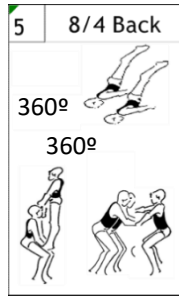

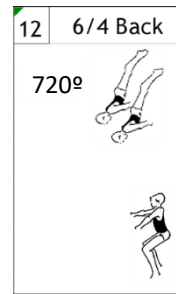

26. Q: In a declared exercise like this 8/4 salto with 360° + 360°, we should give difficulty for this, for example 8/4 (18v) + 360° (8v) +360° (8v) = 34v or, by the way, if doesn't matter where they perform the twists, we should give 8/4 (18v) + 720° (12v)= 30v. Regardless of how it is declared.

A: NO, you have to give to logical answer by the drawing and the twisting in each salto:



Twisting value is 2X 360°

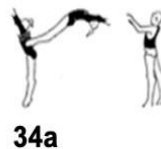
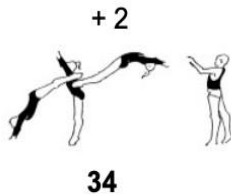

Q: How will this work for value for saltos with 180° twist which now can be either front or back saltos? Value can be different for each direction.

A: Also, in this case you have to give the logical answer by the drawing, take in consideration start and finish position of the element.

27. Q: What is the difference between these elements?



A: *N° 34 is preceded by a Round-Off or/and Flic-Flac,
*N° 34a is starting from stand with a backward jump.

28. Q: Are these 2 elements the same?



A: MG start position 8 can be considered as a variant of position 21 in WG



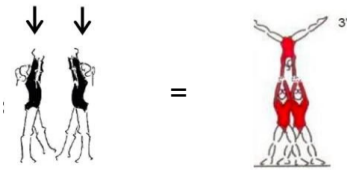

2) Trio Base position pg 65-D6, Category 1, can also be performed standing side by side and is considered as a variant with the same coordinates.

The following catch positions for split are **ALL allowed** (and minor stylistic variations will be accepted e.g., holding the hand or arm and leg or shin – support points optional) and should be added to the appropriate tables of difficulty:



Clarification:

In base positions where the hand(s) or foot/feet of the base are on the floor, the top must grip **ONLY** is permitted for the hand or foot and **NOT** to take additional support on the floor. Otherwise, a penalty of 0.5 for additional support will be applied. (also published in *NL Nr 9, cycle 2017-2021*)

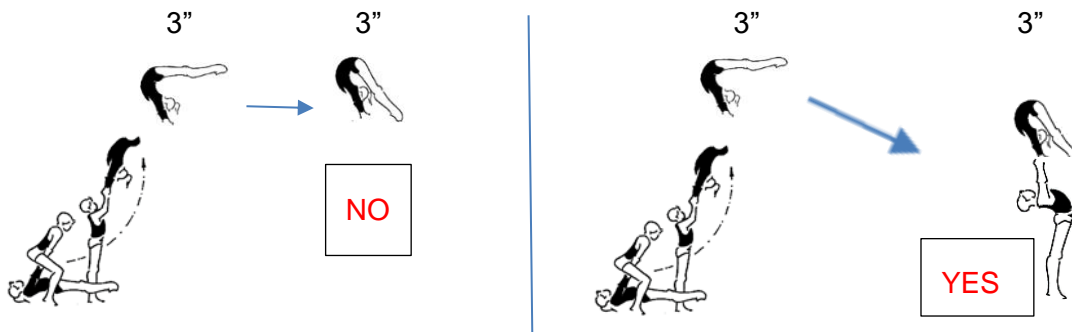

Clarification:

To receive difficulty for 2 different Top positions of the same box it is **not allowed** to perform those two static holds from the same category (BOX page 15 General Rules) one after another **without** anything (e.g. motion of the base) in between.

Example Mount to Mexican 3" and then deep Mexican 3 "



Clarification:

20.18 (4th bullet point) - The top/base is not allowed to use an additional/different point of support in the static hold **during** a transition **for the Top's Start position** to be credited with difficulty.

In this case, when an additional/different point of support is used by the top/base during the transition, the top is considered to be in a position of no value, therefore the difficulty value of the top is zero (0), but the transition value for the base is given. The static hold before the transition and the static hold after the transition may be on different points of support.

Questions and answers:

- Question:** Is a mount performed without a turn or with a turn considered as a different element, even it is the same box with the same ID???

Answer: No, each mount (each box) can be performed only once in the whole exercise.

- Question:** Does a different element than declared on the TSH count for SR?

Answer: Yes, the exception in 15.5 prevails on the general statement in the chapter of submission of TSH in article 38.8

Example:

If a pair is performing only 5 Dynamic elements and only 1 is of them is a catch (all are on the TSH) and they do 1 additional dismount not declared on the TSH, this additional element will receive NO difficulty but will count for the SR of 6 elements but **not** for the SR of 2 catches, so there will be a SR deduction of 1.0 for missing 1 catch.
